

Future Development Path Standards of Conduct

Acceptance to the ACE Enterprises Inc., Future Development Path carries with it the presumption that participants will conduct themselves as responsible citizens while participating in the program. As a condition of admission, all student participants assume responsibility to observe standards of conduct that will contribute to the pursuit of their personal development and to the welfare of the community. That responsibility includes, but is not limited to:

- Practicing high standards of academic, personal and professional honesty and integrity;
- Respecting the rights, privileges, and property of other participants in the program and refrain from any conduct that would interfere with functions or endanger the health, welfare or safety of other persons;
- Complying with the rules, regulations, procedures, policies and standards of conduct.

Standards of Conduct:

Language – At no time shall inappropriate language or name calling be accepted.

Attire – All participants are expected dress appropriately based on specific event or activity. No sagging or incorrectly worn hats will be accepted while part of program.

Timeliness – All participants are expected to be present at ACE sponsored events on time. If problem occurs, participant is asked to contact their ACE represent prior to event.

Attendance – Attendance will be monitored for all ACE events, programs and outings and participants are expected to be part of all activities. If problem or conflicts occur, participant is asked to contact their ACE representative.

Specific instances of misconduct include, but are not limited to:

- Conduct that intentionally and substantially obstructs or disrupts the presentation of any ACE program or freedom of movement or other lawful activity in connection with any ACE sponsored event.

- Physical abuse of any person, or conduct intended to threaten imminent bodily harm or to endanger the health or safety of any person or participant associated with any ACE sponsored event.
- Malicious damage to or malicious misuse of any ACE property, or the property of any person where such property is deemed important to the ACE program.
- Possession or use of firearms, explosives or other dangerous weapons or instrumentalities while involved in ACE sponsored program.
- Unlawful possession, use, or distribution of alcohol or controlled substances while involved in ACE sponsored program.
- Intentionally inciting other participants in any ACE sponsored program to engage in any unlawful activity.
